Keller was awarded a contract for the supply and installation of 1,703 ICP concrete piles requiring 1,646 splices and 176 treated timber piles for the re-design/repair of the Kensington Hwy 1 merge ramps in Burnaby, BC.

- 1,703 ICP concrete piles
- 1,646 concrete pile splices
- Multiple phases and turn overs to GC, working continuous day/night shift

Results/Value

This work was awarded due to our exceptional work at the Port Mann Highway 1 – Willingdon Overpass Project. All work was completed ahead of schedule, under budget with no rework while achieving an exceptional safety record of zero incidents over 10,224 manhours on site.
